4. *Read Genesis chapter 2 (focusing on verses 18-22) and write down in your own words God's purpose for Eve.*

5. *What is important about Chapter 2 verse 24?*

6. *Read Genesis 3. Compare Genesis 3:1-6 with the following verses and jot down what you learn about Satan's activities.*

2 Corinthians 11:12-15

1 Timothy 2:14

- 7. Explain how in Genesis 3:4-5 Satan is able to cast doubt on the things God said concerning the forbidden tree?*

- 8. What areas in your own life is Satan still casting doubt?*

- 9. According to Genesis 3:6, where was Adam during this moment of temptation?*

- 10. Read Genesis 3:7-11. What was Adam and Eve's first response to dealing with their sin? How did God confront their sin?*

11. *What can we learn about our own tendencies in dealing with sin?*

12. *CHALLENGE*** List all the consequences of sin in Genesis 3:14-24*

a. to the serpent

b. to the woman

c. to Adam and the ground

d. to the animals

e. to mankind

13. Read Corinthians 10:11. What is the purpose of Eve and how does she apply to me today?
