## Some Guidelines on Fasting

Fasting - to abstain as a religious sacrifice from solid food; it is about "giving up" something that we value to put our complete trust in God

Jesus set the example of fasting in Matthew 4:1- 2.

### Matthew 4:1-2 New King James Version (NKJV)

**4 Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. <sup>2</sup> And when He had fasted forty days and forty nights, afterward He was hungry.**

Don't get caught in "bondage" about the "40 days and 40 nights". Jesus was defeating the temptations of the devil for us.

Here are a few things to keep in mind about fasting:

- Christians should use fasting as a humbling discipline regularly.
- Our hearts and minds MUST be TOTALLY focused on God so that He may be the FULL SOURCE of our strength during the "fasting period."
- Fasting should come with humility. Others do NOT need to know that we are fasting.

### Matthew 6:17-18 New King James Version (NKJV)

**<sup>17</sup> But you, when you fast, anoint your head and wash your face, <sup>18</sup> so that you do not appear to men to be fasting, but to your Father who is in the secret place; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly.**

- Our motive for fasting should be to "help build up God's Kingdom."
- Prayer should go with fasting and have a targeted goal (specific purpose(s)).
- We should feed our spirit while depriving our flesh which draws us closer to God.

### 2 Corinthians 4:16-18 New King James Version (NKJV)

**<sup>16</sup> Therefore we do not lose heart. Even though our outward man is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day. <sup>17</sup> For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory, <sup>18</sup> while we do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are seen are temporary, but the things which are not seen are eternal.**

- Our spiritual man should be made stronger daily by prayer AND fasting.

### Acts 13:1-3 New King James Version (NKJV)

**13 Now in the church that was at Antioch there were certain prophets and teachers: Barnabas, Simeon who was called Niger, Lucius of Cyrene, Manaen who had been brought up with Herod the tetrarch, and Saul. <sup>2</sup> As they ministered to the Lord and fasted, the Holy Spirit said, "Now separate to Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them." <sup>3</sup> Then, having fasted and prayed, and laid hands on them, they sent them away.**

Before/during fasting, Christians should ask God for the following:

- Ask God to take care of ANY and ALL health issues you may have, i.e. diabetes, organ issues, digestive issues.
- Ask for God's Healing and slowly, with Spiritual Discernment, move into fasting (start by fasting for 30 minutes a day, giving up one meal a day, or giving up one favorite food).

There is one more thing!

Remember, the focus of fasting is to get closer to God and have Him meet and exceed your wants and needs. Our desire should be that God's Will be done on earth - at Mt. Zion and in our personal lives. Our motivation should always be Love and our perspectives must be in the right place.

Christians are to hunger and thirst after righteousness, not the flesh.

**Matthew 5:6 New King James Version (NKJV)**

**<sup>6</sup> Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, For they shall be filled.**
