Inspirations from Heroic Women of the Bible Hidden in Plain Sight

Chapter One Questions

Question: Describe a time (past or present) when you felt hidden. Did others' actions cause you to feel that way, or were you the one trying to hide? How have you experienced God seeking you out in a time when you were hidden from others? What did that experience communicate to you about God: His heart and nature?

Question: What are some things about your past that you feel have defined you? What should a believer's view of their own (or others') broken past be (1 Corinthians 6: 11, 2 Corinthians 5:17)?

Question: Is there a hidden place in your life where you are able to be a witness for Jesus? In what ways are you serving or using your talents and resources to further his kingdom?

Journal: There are times when you need to hide in the shadow of His wings and seek His face, and other times when you should come out of the shadows with boldness and faith. Right now, are you in a season when you need to hide, or when you need to, in Faith, step out into the open?

Action: Consider a woman in your church or ministry who has seems somewhat *hidden* but is actually *heroic*. Spend some time getting to know this lady and encouraging one another. Let her know that God and others see her and value her for her service and devotion.
