The prophet Zephaniah tried to "wake the people up" by pointing out their sinful deeds and urging them to return to God. "Seek ye the LORD, all ye meek of the earth, which have wrought his judgement; seek righteousness, seek meekness: it may be ye shall be hid in the day of the LORD'S anger." (Zephaniah 2:3, KJV). But Judah remained stubborn and refused to obey God. Babylonian invasion, destruction, and captivity was the end result.
