#### During this lesson, we will:


- Explain the hope of vindication for the righteous and faithful

# **About Today's Lesson...**

Psalms 37:28 (KJV) says "For the LORD loveth judgement, and forsaketh not his saints; they are preserved for ever: but the seed of the wicked shall be cut off."

In today's lesson, we return to the ministry of the prophet Isaiah as he continues in an attempt to turn the people of Judah back to God. In today's scriptural passage, Isaiah echoes the sentiment found in Psalms 37:28 - that the Lord our God loves justice! Though times are difficult for these pre-exile Jews, Isaiah reminds them (and us) that "...the Lord GOD will cause righteousness and praise to spring forth before all the nations." (Isaiah 61:11, KJV).

As we enter 2021, let us return to God, repent, and be renewed. Then trust in God's redemption through Christ and rejoice! The "Year of Better" is on the way!
